

Operating Revenues increased from the previous fiscal year to 1,323.0 billion yen. Operating Income decreased from the previous fiscal year to 122.0 billion yen due to the recording of temporary expenses.

# Initiatives for FY2018 Increase Data Usage to Advance the B2B2X Model (2)



### Strengthening and enhancing capabilities to support data usage

Separate customers' data usage processes into three parts for support: "collection," "storage" and "analysis"

#### "Collection"

- Developed "Secure SIM," "IoT Security Platform" and "OT/IT Security Services" to provide appropriate security measures for the types and locations of IoT devices
- Transmits high volumes of data at high reliability and at high speeds from various places and a wide range of devices (⇒ Launched the "JUPITER" submarine cable)

### "Storage"

- Fully utilize globally collected data at the most appropriate locations
   (⇒ Expanded data center coverage and cloud footprint)
- Developed technology to securely store data
  - (⇒ Secret computation technology, secret sharing technology and anonymization technology)


#### "Analysis"
